In August 2006 a group of local citizens formed the Alpharetta Public Safety Foundation, Inc. (APSF) to help Alpharetta remain a safe place to work, live and play by supporting our local police and firefighters.

In 2007 the initial board of directors was joined by a Department of Public Safety Advisory Council consisting of police and firemen and a Business Advisory Council. This means that in our community, ordinary citizens, businessmen and public safety officials meet routinely to discuss their needs and to explore ways to solve current problems and plan for the future.
